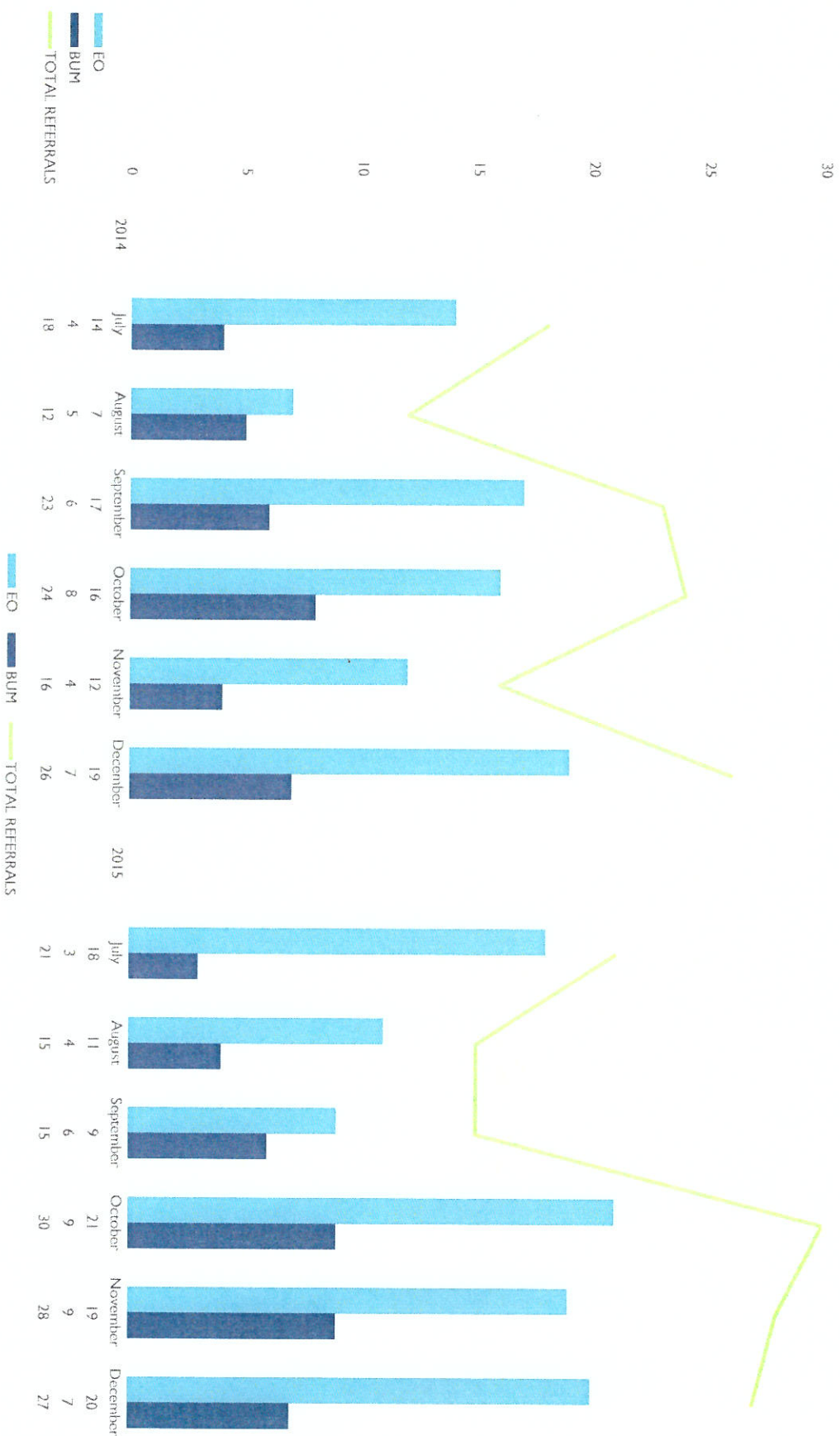
D. Professional Development
